Sub:- South Sub-Division -Petition of Sri. Eshwith Maany Patel Basha against an organisation "**National Human Rights Council (NHRC)**" alleging Misuse of Trademark Registration and Emblem of National Human Rights Commission (NHRC), New Delhi - Enquiry report Submission of - Reg.

Ref:- 1) C.No. 01/G2/NHRC/ACP-S/CCRB/2025 Dated: 18-07-2025 of the office of the Commissioner of Police, Visakhapatnam City

It is submitted that the 2nd reference cited above is the petition addressed to National Human Rights Commission , New Delhi by the petitioner Sri. Eshwith Maany Patel Basha R/o H. No. 7-69/1, Rachapally Village, Sarangapur Mandal, Jagtial Dist of Telangana State with certain allegations against an organization named "**National Human Rights Council (NHRC)**", operating in Andhra Pradesh said to be registered under Trade Mark Registration No. 5202524, Class 45.

ALLEGATIONS : The Organization "*National Human Rights Council (NHRC)*" is :

- 1) Issuing misleading notices to individuals and service organizations to exert pressure and facilitate unlawful settlements.
- 2) And extorting illegal settlements
- 3) Using the NHRC's (National Human Rights Commission) trade mark and infringing the legal rights of others

In this connection enquiry was conducted, surprised the office of "*National Human Rights Council (NHRC)*" located at D.No. 26-50-17,

- It came to know that there are disputes between the petitioner Sri. Eshwith Maany Patel Basha who is resident of Jagitial of Telangana State and the respondent Dr. Sampathkumar as the petitioner and respondent together worked in the same organization earlier.
- Due to difference between the petitioner and the respondent, the petitioner started similar organization at Jagitial Town of Telangana State with the assistance of his colleague Ailaneni Srinivas.
- The respondent Sampath Kumar of Gajuwaka of Andhra Pradesh also sent petitions to DGP and other police officials of Telangana State with the similar allegations against the petitioner's organization.
- Therefore the reference petition is sent by the petitioner to National Human Rights Commission against his rival Sampath Kumar who is running the organization i.e. National Human Rights Counsel willfully as part of their disputes in running the organization.
- My enquiry further reveals no such allegations of misuse of Emblem of National Human Rights Commission by the said organization.

CONCLUSION:

- Therefore the organization is having valid documentation, including a registered trade mark certificate and internal communications, supporting its claim of lawful operations.
- A comparison of the emblem used by the organization with that of the official National Human Rights Commission (NHRC), New Delhi revealed no resemblance. Hence, the allegations are not correct.
- A surprise inspection of the organization's office in Visakhapatnam found no adverse material or activities.
- No concrete evidence was found during the enquiry to support the allegations made in the petition.

Thus, under the facts and circumstances submitted above the allegations made by the petitioner are not correct and it was made due to

personal issues between the two rival organizations working in the States of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh with the same name.
